

FACULTY POSITIONS ANNOUNCEMENT

Walsh University's physical therapist educational program invites applications for two full-time, 12-month, faculty positions available September 1, 2007. Walsh University received approval of a professional doctorate in physical therapy degree program (DPT) from the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) of NCA in March 2007.

Preferred candidates should possess a doctorate (either PhD or professional doctorate in an area other than physical therapy) and university teaching experience. Candidates must hold, or demonstrate eligibility for, a license to practice as a physical therapist in Ohio. Walsh University will consider candidates with a post-professional degree and/or board certification in a physical therapy specialty that also have significant clinical experience in physical therapy and teaching experience at the academic or clinical level.

Position One: We seek an individual with experience and expertise in neuromuscular physical therapy with either adult or pediatric populations. Position specific teaching responsibilities: Co-teach in neuromuscular physical therapy course(s) and assisting in other courses in areas of expertise. Ability to or experience in teaching neuroscience desirable.

Position Two: We seek an individual with experience and expertise in musculoskeletal physical therapy in both acute care and out patient settings. Position specific teaching responsibilities: Coordinate and co-teach musculoskeletal physical therapy course(s) and assisting in other courses in areas of expertise.

Additional position responsibilities include teaching, advising, mentoring student research projects, and professional and curriculum development. Research in the successful candidate's area(s) of interest and service required.
