

## Student/Post-Doc Conference Travel Scholarship

The International Society for Motor Control (ISMC) encourages conference participation by graduate students and post-doctoral fellows. The scholarship program provides funding support for student participation in the conference and is open to both students and post-docs. Our goal is to support 3 individuals with a scholarship of \$500-\$800 each, depending upon our funding status. Preference will be given to students who are nearing the end of their thesis research, and post-docs nearing the end of their training. Only one recipient will be allowed from any laboratory, and those from laboratories of ISMC board members and conference organizers are not eligible to apply. Successful recipients are required to present a poster during the progress in motor control conference. Application for awards will be accepted until April 15th, 2009 (deadline for abstract submission).

Applicants must submit an abstract through the normal abstract submission process. A personal statement, a biosketch (NIH Format), and a letter of recommendation from the applicant's Advisor must accompany the abstract as supplemental information. The personal statement and the letter have a maximum limit of one page. The letter from the advisor must confirm the applicant's status as a post-doc or student.
